Where have we been? Where are we now? Where are we going? This is a good time to reflect on the school year with children. Looking back, children can think about how much they have grown and changed since they were babies. They can share their memories about all of their school experiences and tell about what they've learned.

This is also an opportunity to look ahead. Most children will be going to kindergarten and some will be participating in a second year of prekindergarten. All children should feel a sense of accomplishment and confidence in the knowledge that they are prepared for school next year and for many years after. The first steps toward college and careers started in your classroom!

But we don't want to rush our little learners through childhood. A Big Idea for this theme is "Look what I can do now." You will be assessing each child's growth socially, academically, and physically. You will use the assessments, other indicators, and observations to communicate with families about their children's progress. One of the areas you will observe is persistence, the social-emotional focus for this theme and a critical life skill for today and for tomorrow. You and your children will take note that sticking with a task or trying a new approach can lead to successful results.
