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Dear Families,

The arts start with imagination, and you know that preschoolers have very active ones. So the Big Idea for this theme, "I can imagine all kinds of things," inspires children to create. And while children explore creativity through the arts, they also develop knowledge, vocabulary, and multicultural awareness.

The social-emotional focus on initiative encourages children to feel confident about making and doing art. Some children may start to show a preference for one of the arts when given options for creative expression.

The arts are an excellent means of communication as well as creation. Families will enjoy the efforts of their budding actors, artists, dancers, and music makers and should be encouraged to do art with their children as well as to enjoy their performances. I have three languages for selfexpression— English, Spanish, and Music. I encourage you to get into the act and dance, paint, and sing along.
