Big Idea: I will make friends at school.

**Concepts:** Friendship, what friends do together, friends help each other, making friends when we got to new places, sharing with friends, and friends are alike and different Theme Vocabulary: friends, help, play

### Getting Along – Week 4

Big Idea: I know how to share, and I care about the feelings of others. **Concepts:** Sharing, caring about others and their feelings, saying "I'm sorry," including other children in activities, being a good winner and loser, making other children feel special Theme Vocabulary: cooperate, share, turns

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
