### • Plan a Picnic

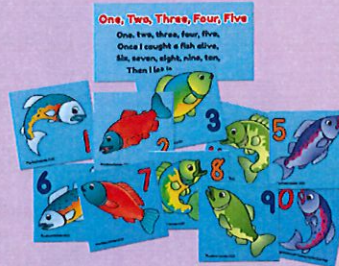
Have a family picnic in your backyard, at the park, or in another spot. Older toddlers will enjoy helping you prepare and pack foods.
